



PHOTOGRAPHY COMPETITION 2014

“People at Work and Play in the Parish of North Mymms”

The Summer Festival being held at St Mary's North Mymms on 28th and 29th June 2014 is a chance to celebrate the community life and talents that can be found within the Parish. As part of that celebration we are running a photographic competition with the title *“People at Work and Play in the Parish of North Mymms”*

Anyone living or working in the Parish is invited to enter up to 3 photographs. The photographs can be of people of any age from children to adults.

The twelve best photographs, as chosen by public vote over the two days of the Festival, will be included in a 2015 Parish Calendar available to buy from October 2014. All proceeds will be shared between the church and local charities.

The photographs should have been taken between 1st January and 31st May 2014. Entries can be submitted between 31st March and 31st May 2014.

RULES

The competition is open to anyone who lives and/or works within the Parish of North Mymms. Anyone professionally engaged in photography is not eligible to enter.

All photographs must have been taken within the Parish of North Mymms between 1st January and 31st May 2014.

The closing date for entries is midnight on the 31st May 2014. Shortlisted entries, as judged by a 3 person panel, will be posted on the St Mary's website and displayed at the St Mary's Summer Festival and the best 12, decided by public vote, will be included in the 2015 Parish Calendar.

Entrants can submit up to three printed photographs, colour or black and white, maximum size A4. An entry form must accompany each photograph. An entry form is attached or can be downloaded from the website.

All entries must be the original work of the entrant. The entrants must be the sole owner of copyright in all photographs entered and must have permission from any people featured in the photograph, or their parents/guardians if the subject is under 16 years of age.

Prior to submission, entrants must not have offered any of their entries for sale, been paid for the publication of any of their entries or won or been runner-up in any photographic competition with any of their entries.

Copyright of the submitted photographs will remain with the photographer. By entering this competition, all entrants grant St Mary's Church the right to publish their photographs both on the website and in printed form. No fees will be payable for the above uses. Photographers will be credited if their photographs are printed in any way.

By entering, entrants will be deemed to be bound by these rules and the judging panel reserves the right to exclude any entry from the competition at any time if it has any reason to believe that an entrant has breached these rules.
